Lifting Supervisor Career Progression, the job of the Lifting Supervisor (LS) is probably the most responsible semi-skilled job in the Lifting Industry. The lifting supervisor is the link between the Lifting Plan and the Lifting Crew who executes the plan. In order to complete these duties (S)he should have a good degree of experience of either Rigging and Slings or Crane Operations in order to appreciate and visualize the execution of the lift, to advise and approve the lifting technique, to consider any changes to the environment that may require an adjustment to the lifting plan in consultation with the Appointed Person who authors and authorizes the lifting plan. LS needs good communication skills, qualities of leadership, confidence and experience in order to organize and lead the team in the execution of the lifting plan.
